There will be 16 yard trap, skeet, pee wee (410) skeet, and trap doubles and/or handicap trap if enough sign up for them. You must have 4 rounds in by Feb. 1st for classification. Signup at the manager's desk. Costs are \$20 for the 1st event and \$10 for each additional event. Junior shooters are \$10 for first event and \$5 each additional. Nonmembers may purchase one shooting card per event for \$35. Get your family, friends and coworkers and have some great winter fun.
